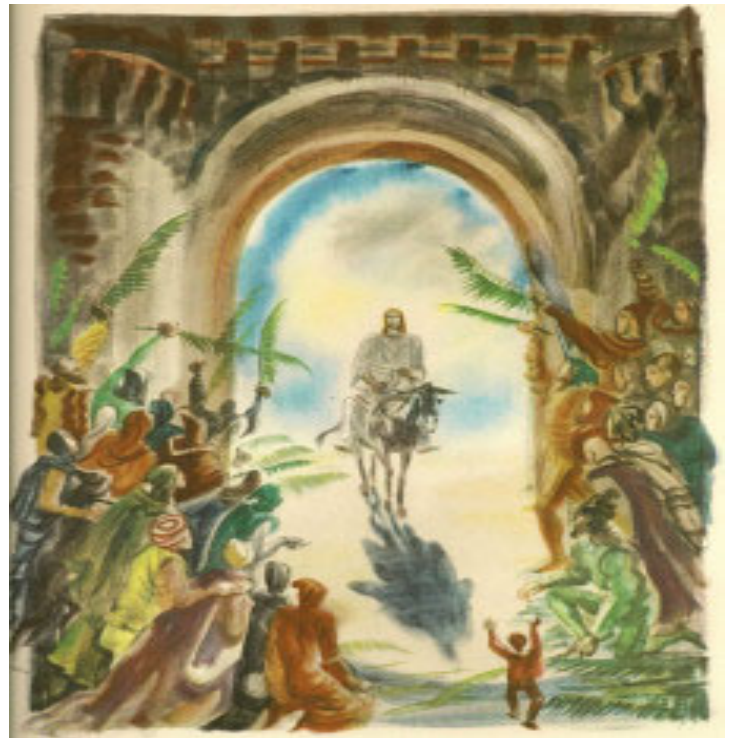

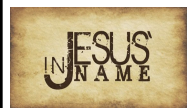

Why do Catholics do that?

Why do Catholics bow at the names of Jesus and Mary?

Bowing is a sign of honor given to royalty and to others of high status. Jesus is the Son of God and our king. Therefore, Mary, his mother, is the Mother of God and our queen. "A bow of the head is made when the three Divine Persons are named together and at the names of Jesus, of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and of the Saint in whose honor Mass is being celebrated" (*General Instruction of the Roman Missal, #275a*).



Divine Mercy Novena

Jesus told St. Faustina "Fortunate is the soul that during life immersed itself in the fountain of My Mercy, for justice will not reach it there. We are sinners in need of God's mercy!"

The Novena begins April 19th after the Good Friday Service at 3pm. Continues on day 2- Holy Saturday at 3pm in Church.

Day 3 is Easter Sunday at 3pm with the rosary to follow. The Novena continues Monday, April 22 through April 27th at 3pm each day.

Divine Mercy Sunday, April 28th 3:00pm Chaplet. Rosary and other prayers.
